

**RELEASE OF LIABILITY, WAIVER OF CLAIMS, INDEMNIFICATION,
AND ARBITRATION AGREEMENT**

Notice – By signing this document you may be waiving certain legal rights, including the right to sue.

Release and Waiver of Claims; Indemnification Agreement

In consideration of being allowed to participate in programs and events (“Programs”) at Cool Sports (the “Facility”), the Participant, and the Participant’s parent(s) or legal guardian(s) if the Participant is a minor, do hereby agree, to the fullest extent permitted by law, as follows:

- 1) **TO WAIVE ALL CLAIMS** that they have or may have against the Facility arising out of the Participant’s participation in the Programs or the use of any equipment provided by the Facility (“Equipment”). The Participant and his/her Parents or legal guardian(s) specifically understand that they are releasing any and all claims that arise or may arise from any **negligent** acts or conduct of the Facility, its owners, affiliates, operators, employees, agents, and officers.
- 2) **TO ASSUME ALL RISKS** of participating in the Programs and using the Equipment, even those caused by the **negligent** acts or conduct of the Facility, its owners, affiliates, operators, employees, agents, and officers. The Participant and his/her Parents or legal guardian(s) understand that there are inherent risks of participating in the Programs and using the Equipment, which may be both foreseen and unforeseen and include serious physical injury and death;
- 3) **TO RELEASE** the Facility, its owners, affiliates, operators, employees, agents, and officers from all liability for any loss, damage, injury, death, or expense that the Participant (or his/her next of kin) may suffer, arising out of his/her participation in the Programs and use of the Equipment; and
- 4) **TO INDEMNIFY** the Facility, its owners, affiliates, operators, employees, agents, and/or officers, from all liability for any loss, damage, injury, death, or expense that the Participant (or his/her next of kin) may suffer, arising out of participation in Programs and use of the Equipment.

Arbitration

The Participant hereby agrees to submit any dispute arising from participation in the Programs to binding arbitration. For such disputes, there shall be a three-member arbitration panel, consisting of two party-appointed arbitrators (one arbitrator to be appointed by each party) and one neutral arbitrator (collectively, the “Panel”), to be chosen by the party-appointed arbitrators. In the event that the two party-appointed arbitrators are not able to agree on a third, neutral arbitrator, the neutral arbitrator shall be appointed by the United States District Court, for Eastern District of Tennessee, Sixth Circuit. Each party shall pay its own costs, including the costs associated with the party-appointed arbitrators, and the parties shall share equally the costs associated with the neutral arbitrator. The arbitration proceeding shall proceed in Knoxville, Tennessee, and shall be governed by the Federal Rules of Evidence. The Panel shall establish a reasonable and appropriate discovery schedule to expeditiously resolve this matter.

The Participant understands that he/she is obligated to follow the rules of the Programs and that he/she can minimize his/her risk of injury through the exercise of common sense and by being aware of his/her surroundings.

If, while participating in the Programs, the Participant observes any unusual hazard, which he/she believes jeopardizes his/her personal safety or that of others, he/she will remove himself/herself from participation in the Programs and immediately bring said hazard to the attention of the Facility.

I HAVE READ AND UNDERSTAND THIS AGREEMENT AND I AM AWARE THAT BY SIGNING THIS AGREEMENT I MAY BE WAIVING CERTAIN LEGAL RIGHTS, INCLUDING THE RIGHT TO SUE.

Parents or Guardians must also sign if the Participant is UNDER 18.

Beginner Skaters

Skaters ages 3– 5 years old are scuttled into the *Snowplow Sam Program*. Skaters in the Snowplow Sam program are required to wear helmets for safety reasons and will follow an 8-week format complete with required elements & fun skating games. Three different skating levels (SPS 1—3) are included in the 3-5 year old category.

New enrollees ages 6—12 should register for the **Basic 1 program**; **skaters ages 13 & older should register for Teen / Adult 1** Program. Classes are designed to cover skating safety tips, required class level elements & the introduction of higher level elements (when it applies). Class evaluations occur the last week of the semester. Each semester of Basic Skills classes includes eight 30-minute lessons once a week, + an End of Season Party and skate rental if needed.

Intermediate Skaters

Intermediate Skaters refers to those skaters moving into **Basic 2—Basic 8 & Teen / Adult 2**.

After successfully completing *Basic 1, Teen / Adult 1* or *Snowplow 3*, skaters are encouraged to continue progressing through all eight (8) levels of the U.S. Figure Skating Basic Skills Program. Many skating elements taught through the eight-level course will help skaters master the art of jumping, spinning, forward & backward skating and prepare skaters for future skating dreams. Skaters will be presented with a colorful USFS skating badge & class certificate upon the completion of each Basic Skills level. Class evaluations occur the last week of the semester. Each semester of the Basic Skills Program includes eight 30-minute lessons once a week, + an End of Season Party and skate rental if needed.
